CHAPTER 61

BUILDINGS

61-07 Discipline in Buildings

13/17

The following rules shall apply to a police building or Government quarter:-

- (a) no quarter or part of quarter is to be sublet;
- (b) spitting is prohibited;
- (c) refuse is to be placed in receptacles designed for that purpose; and
- (d) doors and windows are to be securely fastened whether open or shut.

2. In addition to the preceding paragraph, the following rules apply to barrack accommodation in operational units:-

- (a) a musical instrument, radio, gramophone, etc. should not be played between 2300 hours and 0800 hours;
- (b) lights should be switched off at 2300 hours. If necessary they may be switched on after this for a period of half an hour before and after a change of duty shift;
- (c) alcohol should not be consumed;
- (d) admit a visitor without permission from the DO or Unit Commander; and
- (e) should not admit a person who has been dismissed from the Force.

3. No pet shall be kept in a police building without the consent of the Formation Commander.

4. A male officer, other than an inspecting officer, shall not enter quarters occupied by women police.
