

Procedures of Handling Triad Related Cases

Report

- You may report to any police officer in person, visit any of our police stations.
- You may phone up any police station report room, or the Organized Crime and Triad Bureau's Hotline tel. by 2527 7887, Fax 2804 1896.
- In case of an emergency, please dial 999.

Investigation

- You should recollect any useful information and pass it on to the police, such as date / time / location /
 details of the incident, the alleged triad member / group involved, details of triad expression or
 threatening words / act / gesture, and particulars of witnesses if available.
- Your report will be transferred to an appropriate investigation unit for investigation if in the opinion of the Duty Officer of the report room a crime may have been committed.
- Police will keep your personal particulars confidential.

Follow-up Enquiries

- You and other witnesses will be invited to give statements for further enquiries.
- Police may collect from you any evidence or exhibit in connection with the case for enquiries.
- Contact will be maintained with you and if you have any fresh information, do not hesitate to inform the investigating officers. (Contact telephone numbers are available)
- Police will consider offering you witness protection at any stage if necessary.

Arrest of Suspect

- When an arrest is made, you may be required to attend an identification parade if you have seen the suspect. (A one-way viewer identification parade room can be used if required.)
- In case of prosecution, you may have to attend court and give evidence.
- You will be notified about the case result or progress of the investigation in due course.
