Notes

- Applicant should produce the vehicle owner's and driver's Hong Kong Identity Card, Closed Area Permit, driving licence, and vehicle registration documents and motor vehicle licence for verification.
- For authorized vehicle, only the specified resident of closed area will be accepted as driver. The applicant should also produce authorization document from the vehicle owner.
- Closed Road Permit is valid for a maximum period of one year.
- Closed Road Permits are issued free of charge but replacement for loss, defaced or damaged permits will be issued subject to the levy of a charge of \$86 in accordance with the relevant legislation.

Collection of Personal Data

- The information provided to the Commissioner of Police will be used for the purpose relating to the application for Closed Road Permit.
- The Commissioner of Police has the right to pass part of or all information to other departments authorized by law.
- According to the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance, the applicant has the right of access or correction with respect to personal data. Request for personal data access or correction should be made to Chief Inspector (Administration) Border District, in writing.
