

Language Proficiency Requirements

Applicants should:

- Have Level 2 (Note 1) or above in English Language in HKDSEE/HKCEE, or equivalent;
- Have Level 2 (Note 1) or above in Chinese Language in HKDSEE/HKCEE, or equivalent.
- Applicants not meeting the minimum required Chinese or English language proficiency requirement may still apply. They will be invited to attend the Written Examination and the **Practical Incident Handling Test**. They will be considered as meeting the language proficiency requirements of if they have a pass in the Chinese and/ or English Papers of Written Examination (Complete 50 to 60 multiple-choice questions within an hour with the pass mark at 50 scores) **Online Mock Examination (Chi) / Online Mock Examination (Eng);**)
- Be able to read and write Chinese and speak fluent Cantonese.

Note

For civil service appointment purpose, Grade C and Grade E in Chinese Language and English Language (Syllabus B) in the HKCEE before 2007 are accepted administratively as comparable to Level 3 and Level 2 respectively in Chinese Language and English Language in the 2007 HKCEE and henceforth.
