

Impromptu Talk

Impromptu Talk means a talk without preparation. This exercise consists of two parts: one in Cantonese, one in English, and the duration of which is two minutes each. This is the first assessment exercise in which the candidates' verbal power of expression in both languages is tested. It will also be seen whether a candidate can communicate effectively by expressing his / her thoughts in a logical way and whether they are confident in speaking before a group. A candidate's ability to overcome the initial stress and think fast under the spotlight will be made apparent.
