Selected Traffic Enforcement Priorities 2018

In order to reduce casualties and maintain a smooth traffic flow on Hong Kong's roads, the Police will take stringent enforcement actions against the following types of offences committed by road users who choose to contravene the law.

Types of Offences the Police will Strictly Enforce

Driving Attentiveness



- Careless driving
- Traffic signal, sign & road marking offences
- Using handheld telecommunication equipment whilst driving

Pedestrian Safety



- Climbing over fence and jay walking
- Disobeying pedestrian red light signal & traffic signs
- Crossing within 15m of pedestrian crossing facilities

Cycling Safety



- Careless cycling
- Traffic signal, sign & road marking offences
- Riding without lights during hours of darkness

Impaired Driving





- Drink driving
- Driving under the influence of drugs

Irresponsible Behaviour



- Dangerous driving
- Insecure load and Overloading
- Yellow striped light signal crossing offence
- Taximeter offences / Overcharging, Refusing hire, Soliciting passengers for hire
- Double white line offence
- Seat belt offences

- Motor racing & speed trials
- Speeding

Traffic Congestion



- Parking on footpaths
- Illegal Parking causing unnecessary obstruction / congestion
- Unlawfully entering box junction
- Stopping in restricted zone
- Picking up / setting down passengers in restricted zone
- Loading / unloading goods in restricted zone
