

Selected Traffic Enforcement Priorities 2022

In order to reduce casualties and maintain a smooth traffic flow on Hong Kong's roads, the Police will take stringent enforcement actions **<u>without discretion</u>** against the following types of offences committed by road users.

Types of Offences the Police will Strictly Enforce	
Traffic Congestion	 Parking on footpaths Illegal Parking causing unnecessary obstruction / congestion Unlawfully entering box junction Stopping in restricted zone Picking up / setting down passengers in restricted zone Loading / unloading goods in restricted zone Unauthorized stopping at bus stop
Inattentive Driving	 Careless driving Traffic signal, sign & road marking offences Using handheld telecommunication equipment whilst driving Double white line offence
Irresponsible Behaviour	 Insecure load and overloading Taximeter offences, overcharging, refusing hire, soliciting passengers for hire Seat belt offences
Pedestrian Safety Related	 Climbing over fence and jay walking Disobeying pedestrian red light signal & traffic signs Crossing within 15m of pedestrian crossing facilities Yellow striped light signal crossing offence Failing to give precedence to pedestrians on a zebra crossing
Illegal Road Racing & Speeding	 Motor racing & speed trials Dangerous driving Speeding
Impaired Driving	 Drink driving Driving under the influence of drugs
Bicycles & Electric Mobility Devices	 Driving an unlicensed vehicle Driving without a driving licence Driving without 3rd party insurance Careless cycling Riding without lights during hours of darkness
