有兩女一子、現年47歲的Fanny,在醫院擔任抽血員13年。從 今年四月起,她再接受一項新挑戰,就是換上戎裝,成為輔警維

Fanny年少時已展現見義勇為的性格。「16歲那年,我和同學在 便利店內,見到一名男子站在對面馬路向我們『露械』。我不單未有 害怕,還嘗試追出去,不過那名壞人很快失去蹤影,那一刻既憤怒又

> 無奈。報案後,我登上警車協助 警察兜截,親睹很多警察分工合 作落力追捕,深受感動。」縱然 當日未能成功擒人,但這次經 歷,已在Fanny心中埋下成為警 察的種子。

> Fanny讀書至中三後便投身 社會,工作多年後,她深感自己 學歷不足限制了職業發展,因此 報讀毅進課程,獲得等同會考五 科合格的學歷。重拾課本,讓她 明白知識的重要,亦激發她學習 一門專業技能,以助謀生。

偶然的機會,Fanny決定成為一名抽血員。不過訓練期間,她卻 遇上意想不到的難題,「由於我是左撇子,導師一時難以換轉方向, 手把手地教我落針。我只能按照他建議,以拮橙作為額外練習方 式,比其他同學多下苦功,使我可在半年受訓期內,如期考獲抽 血員資格,自此在醫院服務病人。」

Fanny事業變得穩定,但二零一九年的黑暴事件對她產生 巨大衝擊,「當時兩名女兒分別就讀大學和高中,我很擔心 她們的觀念會受到影響。相比追求學歷和成就,我更希望 她們做人正直誠實,為社會帶來貢獻,因此我決定以身作 則投考輔警,我希望像30年前幫助我的警察一樣儆惡懲 奸。」

Fanny待初生兒子最需要照顧的關鍵幾年過後,便投考輔 警。為應付遴選,她每星期最少進行三至四次長跑訓練,務求盡快<mark>回</mark> 復狀態。憑著為女兒樹立正面榜樣的決心,她最終成<mark>功獲得</mark>取錄。回 憶在受訓過程中,波折不少,例如在射擊方面,她又<mark>再碰上左撇子的</mark> 煩惱,幸得教官耐心指導,她克服困難,終於如願成為輔警。

作為母親,她希望繼續以自己鍥而不捨的精神感染子女。大女大 學畢業後,Fanny鼓勵她投考警務督察;細女正修讀護士課程,希望 踏其足印,投身醫療界;而Fonny自己,無論是醫院正職或作為輔 警,她都堅持繼續用心服務市民。

資訊系統部人員於四月十七日至二十一日 在瑞士日內瓦參與第49屆日內瓦國際發明展, 勇奪五項金獎及一項銀獎,當中包括最高榮譽 的評審團嘉許金獎。

今年大會吸引超過40個國家及地區共逾 1 000項發明參展。資訊系統部以「公眾安全 新概念」為主題,呈交六個以智慧搜救及情報 主導巡邏有關的數碼項目參賽,展示警隊以創 新科技為本的數碼警政理念。

緊急手機應用程式HKSOS今年再於「保 安、搜救及警報」組別中獲得評審團嘉許金 獎;其餘四個金獎項目分別為Signal Radar搜 救無人機、HKSOS無線網狀網絡、智慧行動耳 機Techsense和智慧巡邏手機應用程式 i-Patrol;而智慧搜救地圖R-Map則獲銀獎。日 內瓦國際發明展評判團主席David Taji Farouki 亦對香港警察參展項目的水平給予高度評價及 肯定。

助理處長(資訊系統)關翠貞對團隊再取 佳績深感光榮。HKSOS早於上屆發明展以智慧 搜救的元素獲得評審團嘉許金獎,今年HKSOS 概念成真,正式推出並得到市民廣泛使用,其 人工智能模式在是次發明展備受肯定,再次獲 最高殊榮,令研發團隊感到鼓舞。

HKSOS除了在香港應用外,亦在迪拜沙漠 成功通過實地測試。人員今次更與瑞士警察搜 救隊在雪山進行實地測試,成效斐然。瑞士當 局認為HKSOS有助雪地搜救行動,高度讚賞其 技術及實體應用。此次實地測試進一步展示警 隊的創科實力,未來將探討與更多國家及地區

是次六個參賽項目為警隊與香港本地科創 公司主動研發,當中有五項已成功取得專利。 警隊未來在傳統搜救行動和日常巡邏工作將<mark>輔</mark> 以先進科技系統及設備,以提升警政效能。

新界北總區的智慧圍網保護系統於第49屆 日內瓦國際發明展獲得銅獎。智慧圍網保護系 統引入人工智能技術,除全面提升現有的閉路 電視及震動警報系統外,亦新增車牌識別、數 據分析及緊急求助三個新功能,為人員提供更 準確及快捷的預警, 便利需要進出禁區的市民

為加強邊界保安工作及配合數碼時代的警 政需求,新界北總區正全面更換運作逾十年的 圍網保護系統。新系統已於二零二三年一月至 七月在落馬洲得月樓一帶成功完成先導計劃, 並將於今年下半年分階段把智慧圍網保護系 統應用至整道邊界圍網。





# 2024年重點交通執法項目

2024年重點交通執法項目已於四月八日發布並即時生效,當中包括28件違例事項。行人(尤其長者)仍是二零二三年最容易受傷的道路使用者組別。另外,貨車、的士及小巴是涉及最多致命交通意外的車種,而不專注駕駛仍是交通意外的主要成因。

道路安全是二零二四年處長首要行動項目之一。警隊根據每年的交通意外及相關違例罪行的最新趨勢,針對不同道路使用者而制定重點交通執法項目,冀改變道路使用者引致交通意外和阻礙道路的不良行為,減少交通意外中死亡及嚴重

受傷的人數,以及應對社區關注的道路安全事 項。

重點交通執法項目的成效是以成果為本 (整體道路安全情況),而非執法數字 來衡量,同時有必要採取更嚴厲的執 法行動應對上述事宜。因此,交 通總部會繼續定期統籌全港性 主題執法行動,並協調各總 區及警區的交通警力, 務求以最少的資源達 致最大的效果。

## 混合實境訓練系統啟動禮

警察機動部隊總部於四月二十九日舉行混合 實境訓練系統啟動禮,由警察機動部隊校長莫慶 榮及機電工程署高級工程師邱芝瑩主持儀式。該 系統為警察機動部隊總部研究及發展組牽頭的創 新項目,已於今年首季在警察機動部隊的戰術訓 練上率先試行,並獲高度評價。


傳統的戰術訓練受制於場地及人手等因素影響,而新引入的系統則結合虛擬和擴增實境的元素,讓受訓人員能透過開放式頭戴顯示器與虛擬物體和真實環境互動,利用感知技術、顯示技術、空間映射等讓人員猶如置身現場。教官可利用系統構建不同場景,使人員在逼真且安全的環境下進行演練,既節省資源,也提高訓練效能。

網絡安全及科技罪案調查科(網罪科)與政府電腦保安事故協 調中心(協調中心)於四月二十五日合辦第八屆跨部門網絡安全演 習,以提升各政府部門對網絡攻擊的防範意識及整體應變能力。

助理處長(刑事)鍾詠敏致辭時強調,面對與日俱增的網絡攻擊,是次演習着力加強參與者應對各類型網絡威脅的能力,全面提 升政府在預防、偵測及應對網絡攻擊方面的整體實力。

演習採用線上線下同步模式,吸引250多位來自70個政府部門的資訊科技人員參與。演習設置實戰演練系統,讓參與者就各種網絡攻擊場景交流,進行事故應變及調查。

是次演習體現政府維護網絡安全的決心和能力,網罪科會繼續 與協調中心及各政府部門合作,共同築起政府網絡安全防線。

課程分為兩部分,首三天分別由 新界北總區快速應變部隊、重點及搜查 組及註冊山藝教練教授涵蓋山嶺導行、 地圖與指南針的運用、野外搜索、重點 搜索技巧等專業知職。其後,人員接受 由民安處安排為期五天的山嶺搜救訓練 課程,學習山嶺導行、搜索及搶救的技 巧,教授學員安全和有效地執行前線山 嶺搜救工作。

參與課程的新界北總區快速應變 部隊高級督察梁益彰表示是次訓練期間 曾遇上不穩定天氣,更能加強學員在惡

劣環境下搜救或在山林搜捕匪徒和證物的應變能力。民安處高級行動及訓練主任(特遣部 隊)文偉光在課程總結時,寄語學員繼續累積經驗才能有效和安全地在山嶺執行任務,亦希 望民安隊與警隊及其他救援部隊在發生緊急山嶺事故時能加強合作。

是次課程加深人員對民安隊山嶺工作的了解<sup>,</sup>而不同單位的導師及學員亦藉此交流山嶺 搜救經驗,並促進雙方在行動中的協作。學員完成訓練並通過考核後,均獲頒資歷架構第三 級的山嶺搜救訓練證書及一級山藝訓練證書。

The officers also explained how to identify cannabis edibles and had members of the public experience drug scent simulations and understand the characteristics and harms of drugs.

NB officers visited tertiary institutions in April to disseminate anti-drugs messages among 200 tertiary students. The simulated drugs and druginhaling apparatus displayed at the seminars also deepened the participants' understanding of drug hazards.





# 8th Inter-departmental Cyber Security Drill

The Cyber Security and Technology Crime Bureau (CSTCB) and the Government Computer Emergency Response Team (GovCERT. HK) co-hosted the 8th Inter-Departmental Cyber Security Drill on April 25 to enhance the awareness and overall responsiveness of various government departments to cyberattacks.

During her opening speech, Assistant Commissioner (Crime) Chung Wing-man emphasised that in the face of escalating cyberattacks, the drill would focus on strengthening participants' capabilities to respond to various types of cyber threats, thereby comprehensively enhancing the government's overall strength in preventing, detecting, and responding to cyberattacks.

The drill adopted a hybrid online and offline mode, attracting participation of over 250 IT personnel from 70 government departments. It featured realistic training systems that allowed



# 'Spot and Report'

logistics sector

he Inter-departmental Counter Terrorism Unit (ICTU) has launched the Logistics Sector "Spot and Report" Campaign since September last year. With this April coinciding with the 6th anniversary of ICTU's establishment, Senior Superintendent of ICTU Leung Wai-ki and Group Head (Counter Terrorism), Intelligence Bureau of Hong Kong Customs and Excise Department (C&ED) Ms Ho Mei-ling reported the achievements of the campaign on April 22.

For the six months upon the launch of the campaign, ICTU and C&ED have reached out to 67 cross-boundary and local logistics and transport companies. A total of 27 and 60 cases involving firearms and weapons respectively have been received since the start of the campaign. Among these cases, 19 of the firearm cases and 48 of the weapon cases were reported on the own initiative of the logistics sector, showing doubledigit increases when compared with the number before the launch of campaign. Apart from arranging staff to attend talks organised by ICTU, some of the companies publicise related information internally or on their intranets to raise their staff's counter-terrorism awareness. Some logistics companies even arrange to have advertisements posted on their smart lockers to promote the message of "Spot and Report" to the public.





## **TKODIST's briefing** on extreme weather

With the typhoon season around the corner, Tseung Kwan O District (TKODIST) organised a briefing on April 23 to enhance the operational efficiency and competency of frontline officers in handling extreme weather situations. More than 30 officers from Patrol Subunit, Task Force Sub-unit (TFSU), Operations Support Sub-unit, Administration Support Sub-unit, Miscellaneous Enquiries Sub-unit, Police Community Relations Office and the Special Duties Squad attended the briefing.

TFSU Commander of TKODIST Man Lap-hang introduced to the officers the newly procured protective clothing and life-saving equipment for effective operations in extreme weather situations. District Commander of TKODIST Mak Man-yu also shared previous operational experience and salient points from last year's symposium on Inter-Departmental Collaboration for Coping with Extreme Weather. He reminded frontline officers that they should get prepared and be ready to save life and property during extreme weather.

# Rural Functional

24 officers from the New Territories North (NTN), New Territories South, Kowloon East, Hong Kong Island and Police Tactical Unit Headquarters completed the eight-day Rural Functional Training Course held respectively at NTN Regional Headquarters and Civil Aid Service (CAS) Headquarters between April 17 and 26.

The course comprised two parts. The first three days were hosted by Quick Reaction Force (QRF) of NTN, Key Points and Search Division and registered mountain craft coaches, covering professional knowledge such as trail orienteering, use of map and compass, countryside search and key point search. Subsequently, trainees attended the five-day training provided by CAS in mountain search and rescue (SAR) to learn about mountain orienteering, SAR techniques for discharging

frontline mountain SAR duties safely and effectively.

Senior Inspector of QRF NTN Leung Yik-cheung, a trainee of the course, said that the unstable weather during the training period strengthened the trainees' responsiveness in performing SAR duty with extreme weather environment or searching for culprits and evidence in the rural area. In his

concluding speech, Senior Operations and Training Officer (Tactical Force) of CAS Mr Man Wai-kong encouraged the trainees to strengthen their knowledge and skills in SAR for conducting operation in mountains safely and effectively. He hoped that the collaboration between CAS, police and other rescue units could be further enhanced when handling mountain SAR operations.

The course deepened the officers' understanding about mountaineering duties of CAS while the instructors and trainees from different formations also took the opportunity to exchange experiences in mountain search for better synergy in real cases. Upon completion of the course. trainees were awarded with both the Certificate in Mountain SAR Training under the Qualifications Framework Level 3 and Mountain Craft Training Certificate Level 1.



## Force's works awarded in Mainland

## Selected Traffic Enforcement Priorities 2024

Selected Traffic Enforcement Priorities (STEP) 2024 comprising 28 traffic offences was issued on April 8 and has taken immediate effect. Pedestrians, especially elderly pedestrians, continued to be the most vulnerable road user group in 2023. Moreover, goods vehicles, taxis and mini-buses were the vehicle types involving the highest number of fatal traffic accidents while inattentive driving was still the main contributory factor for traffic accidents.

Road safety is one of the Commissioner's Operational Priorities for 2024. Based on the prevailing trend of traffic accidents and related offences every year, the Force formulates traffic enforcement operations targeting different road users, with a view to changing the undesirable

behaviours of road users that cause accidents and obstruction on roads, reducing the number of persons killed and seriously injured in traffic accidents and addressing road safety issues of community concern.

The effectiveness of STEP is measured by outcomes (overall road safety situation) as opposed to outputs (enforcement figures) and more stringent enforcement efforts and operations addressing the above are necessary. As such, Traffic Branch Headquarters will continue to co-ordinate Force-wide thematic operations periodically and align concerted efforts of Regions and Districts to achieve maximum impact with minimum resources.

## **Mixed Reality Training System launched**

The Police Tactical Unit Headquarters (PTU HQ) held the launching ceremony of the Mixed Reality (MR) Training System on April 29. Commandant of PTU HQ Mok Hing-wing and Senior Engineer of the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department (EMSD) Ms Yau Chi-ying officiated at the ceremony. The system is an innovative project led by the Research and Development Division of PTU HQ. It underwent trial and testing in the first quarter of 2024 for PTU Tactics Training with very positive comments received.

Traditional tactics training may be affected by factors such as the venue and manpower. The newly introduced system incorporates elements of virtual reality and augmented reality to allow users to interact with virtual objects and the real environment through an open-view head-mounted display. With perception technology, display technology and spatial mapping, the system creates an immersive experience to the trainees. Instructors can simulate different training scenarios in the same training venue, allowing trainees to undergo training in a realistic and safe environment, whilst saving resources and improving training effectiveness.

# Force shines again at International Exhibition of Inventions of Geneva

Officers of the Information Systems Wing (ISW) garnered five Gold Medals, including the most prestigious Gold Medal with the Congratulations of Jury, and one Silver Medal in the 49th International Exhibition of Inventions of Geneva held in Geneva, Switzerland between April 17 and 21.

This year, more than 1 000 inventions from over 40 countries and regions took part in the event. With the theme of Reinventing of Public Safety, ISW submitted six digital entries regarding smart rescue solutions and intelligence patrol to showcase its determination in technology-driven digital policing.

Emergency mobile app HKSOS won the prestigious Gold Medal with the Congratulations of the Jury again under the "Security - Rescue - Alarm" category. The other four Gold-Medal awarded projects were Signal Radar Search and Rescue (SAR) Drone, HKSOS Emergency Wireless Mesh Network, smart operational earpods "Techsense" and smart patrol mobile app "i-Patrol", while Project R-Map received Silver Medal. The President of the Jury of the International Exhibition of Inventions of Geneva Mr David Taji Farouki highly praised and acknowledged the level of sophistication and creativity of the Hong Kong Police's projects.

Assistant Commissioner (Information Systems) Kwan Chui-ching felt honoured with the team for triumphing again this year. HKSOS won the Gold Medal with Congratulations of Jury for its "Smart Rescue" concept last year. This year marked the successful rollout of HKSOS, which has brought the concept to reality and has been enthusiastically embraced by the public. The project's AI Mode received high praise at this exhibition, earning the project the same prestigious award again, which greatly motivated the team.

Apart from the application of HKSOS in Hong


Kong, HKSOS has also been field-tested in Dubai desert successfully. This time, the app has also made its way to Switzerland for on-site testing with the SAR team of the Swiss Police in the snowy mountains, yielding remarkable results. The Swiss Police found HKSOS conducive to SAR operations on snow and highly praised its technology and practical application. This on-site testing further showcased the technological capabilities of the Force and its potential to have further co-operation with more countries and regions in the future.

These six solutions, five of which have been patented successfully, are jointly invented by the Force and the local innovation and technology companies. In its traditional SAR operation and daily police patrol in the future, the Force will be facilitated with advanced technology and equipment for higher policing efficiency and accuracy.

The Smart Fence Protection System (SFPS) of North Territories North (NTN) won a bronze medal at the 49th International Exhibition of Inventions of Geneva. Al technology has been integrated into SFPS. In addition to upgrading the existing CCTV and vibration alarm systems, three new components, namely License Plate Recognition, Data Analysis, and SOS, have been introduced to the new system to provide frontline officers with precise and timely alerts of boundary incidents and offer greater convenience for citizens and vehicles requiring access to the Frontier Closed Area.

To enhance boundary security and meet the policing needs in the digital age, NTN is replacing its decade-old Fence Protection System comprehensively. The new system successfully completed its pilot scheme in the vicinity of Tak Yuet Lau in Lok Ma Chau Division from January to July 2023. Starting from the second half of this year, NTN will apply the new SFPS to the whole section of boundary fence by phases.

# Helped by police 30 years ago Mother of three joins AUX to lead by deed

anny, 47 years old with two daughters and a son, has been a phlebotomist in a hospital for 13 years. Since April this year, she has taken a new challenge by upholding law and order as an auxiliary (AUX) police constable.

Fanny has an extraordinary sense of justice since she was young. "The year when I was 16, my classmate and I shopped in a convenient store and saw a flasher exposing indecently to us across the street. Instead of being afraid, I went out to chase him but in vain. I was angry and helpless. After calling the police, I boarded a police car to assist in arresting the suspect. I was deeply touched by the scene that there were many officers working on this wholeheartedly." Although they could not arrest the suspect that day, the seed of joining frontline police work was planted in Fanny's heart.

Fanny started working after graduating from Form 3. Since the lack of academic qualifications limited her career development, Fanny enrolled in the Diploma Yi Jin Programme and finally got the qualification as having five subjects passed in Hong Kong Certificate of Education Examination. She realised the importance of knowledge and therefore started looking for an expertise as her next learning goal.

Fanny decided to become a phlebotomist later, but she encountered an unexpected problem during training. "As I am left-handed, the instructor had difficulty in changing his direction when teaching me how to set the needle. I followed his suggestion and made use of an orange for extra practice. I was hence able to be qualified to be a phlebotomist after half a year of training. I have been working in a hospital since then."

Fanny's career became stable until the riot in 2019, which had a huge impact on her. "My two daughters were at university and secondary school respectively. I was very worried that their values would be influenced. In comparison to pursuing academic qualifications and achievements, I focused more on their integrity and contribution to society. Therefore, I decided to lead by deed and set a positive example for them. I wish to fight crime and become the policemen that helped me 30 years ago."

A few years after her son was born, Fanny applied to join the AUX police. To cope with the selection process, she practiced distance running at least three to four times a week to get back into shape. With her perseverance to set examples for her daughters, she finally got admitted. She recalled that her shooting training was full of setbacks. For example, she had to face the troubles of being left-handed again. With the instructor's patient guidance, Fanny finally passed all the assessments and became an AUX officer.

As a mother, she hopes that her children can learn from her perseverance. Fanny encouraged her elder daughter to apply for probationary inspector after her graduation. As for the younger daughter, she has already followed in Fanny's footsteps by attending a nursing course. As for Fanny herself, no matter whether being a full-time hospital worker or an AUX officer, she will continue to serve the public with her whole
