街文隊最精鋭的反恐部隊、綽號「飛虎隊」的特別任務 **声** 連,一九七四年成立至今已半世紀。現年**60**歲的警署 警長李偉成(洋名Gima),投身警隊42年,一九八八年 通過特警遴選,成功入圍飛虎隊考核。

Gima透露,很多電影情節在選拔中確有其事,「教 官會深夜吵醒考生執行任務,亦會讓考生身處黑房中應變 突襲,每一刻都是考核環節,即使坐下休息時,教官仍繼 續測試我們的觀察力和記憶力。」

經過為期14天的精挑細選後,20多名入圍考生中僅八 人能夠進入下一階段的訓練,經過幾輪淘汰後,最終只餘 Gima和另外兩人獲得取錄,成為飛虎隊一員。入隊後 Gima獲派擔任狙擊手,負責進行埋伏和掩護等任務。

駐守飛虎隊約30年,Gima最難忘兩次行動:一次是 一九九二年荃灣廣州樓案,與匪徒爆發激烈槍戰,在槍林 彈雨中成功擒獲所有匪徒;另一次是奉命在米埔紅樹林一 間鐵皮屋外埋伏,等待時機拘捕軍火集團成員。「那時正 值酷暑,我們由前期勘察、潛伏就位到任務結束,足足兩 個月之久。蚊蟲以至紅火蟻的叮咬,讓人既癢又痛,極難 忍受,但全體隊員堅守崗位,最終成功搗破團夥,並起獲 大量槍械。|

一九九八年,Gima獲委任為飛虎隊教官,見證飛虎 隊在考核和訓練上的不斷提升。「以游水為例,以往只著 重途程,現時則加入各種數據分析,學員須多方達標才可 完成訓練;而過去的兩周進階遴選,亦濃縮為更精煉的七 天『地獄周』;為協助有意投考者提早作準備,飛虎隊亦 主動舉辦先修課程。」

面對瞬息萬變的反恐形勢,飛虎隊成員要時刻備戰。 Gima強調:「我們的責任,一如入隊的初心,就是以最 佳狀態守護香港。」他鼓勵體能卓越、性格堅毅的同袍, 投考包括飛虎隊等特警部門,接受挑戰。

二零一九年從飛虎隊退役後,Gimq以退休後服務合 約方式繼續為警隊服務,現於警察機動部隊總部研究及發 展科致力研發及採購裝備,包括協助引入現時前線人員使 用的防刺背心,以及混合實境訓練系統等,為警隊引進更 多優良裝備,令同袍如虎添翼。

積極搭建警隊與「一帶一路」沿線國家執法機構的合作夥伴 **為**關係,副處長(管理)陳俊燊率領一行14人代表團於六月三 日至七日訪問烏茲別克斯坦共和國(烏茲別克斯坦),此行為警隊 首次前赴烏茲別克斯坦參與培訓及交流。

交通總部向立法會交通事務委員會

•••• 示範電子交通告票平台功能••••

《2023年電子執行交通法例(雜項修訂)條例草案》已於六月十九 2日獲立法會通過,警隊計劃於二零二五年內逐步推行定額罰款通 知書(告票)電子化及分階段推出電子交通告票平台(平台)。為讓 立法會議員可深入了解籌備工作,警方邀請立法會交通事務委員會主 席陳恒鑌博士、委員易志明和劉業強及立法會議員陳家珮於六月 二十四日到訪警察交通總部,了解新平台及發出電子告票的流程。

助理處長(支援)區永樑帶領人員向議員介紹電子化的籌備工

作,並展示平台網站和手機應用程式。該網站為公眾提供一站式服務,車主及司機可隨時查閱電子告票及透過電子方式繳付罰款。議員與人員積極交流意見,期望透過科技提升交通執法效率,推動智慧出行的發展。

為配合告票電子化於執法上帶來的流程轉變,交通總部將適時更新警隊電話應用程式「e525」及「e570」,並為前線人員舉辦訓練工作坊。

優化巡邏車安全帶設計

為減低人員在警車上替被捕人繫上安全 帶時的受襲風險,交通總部運輸課與機電工 程署合作設計新安全帶。

新設計在中排雙座椅的左右兩側增設輔助扣,而後排中間兩個被捕人座位的安全帶方向則改為由車內向車外方向緊扣。在被捕人上車前,人員先將被捕人座位的安全帶拉至輔助扣,當戴上手銬的被捕人就座後,人

員無需跨到被捕人身前,而是將安全帶從輔助扣中解開並繫至被捕人座位的安全扣。

警隊將於七月開始為239輛巡邏車更 換安全帶,並會優先改裝五大總區衝鋒 隊警車,預計於二零二五年中完成。 未來在採購警隊大型客貨車時,新 設計將列為標準要求,以提高運 送被捕人的安全性和效率。

今期介紹《條例》第十部—鄭國家秘密及 間諜活動相關罪行, 此都分完善了現行 《官方機密條例》中的相關罪行。

《條例》第4部:國家秘密及間諜相關罪行

第29條「國家秘密」的涵義

關乎以下任何一項秘密,在沒有合法權限下披露,相當可能 危害國安,即屬國家秘密



- ▶ 中國或特區事務的重大決策的秘密
- ▶ 中國國防建設或中國武裝力量的秘密
- ▶ 中國外交或外事活動的秘密、特區對外事務的秘密, 或中國或特區對外承擔保密義務的秘密
- ▶ 中國或特區經濟或社會發展的秘密
- ▶ 中國或特區科技發展或科學技術的秘密
- ▶ 維護國家安全或特區安全或偵查罪行的活動的秘密
- ▶ 中央與特區之間的關係的秘密

第32/33/35條 - 非法獲取/管有/披露國家秘密



- ▶ 任何人沒有合法權限下,獲取/管有/披露資料、文件或物品:
 - ▶明知該資料屬或載有國家秘密;或
 - ▶有合理理由相信該資料屬或載有國家秘密,並意圖危害 國家安全

第43條 - 間諜活動

- ▶ 如任何人意圖危害國家安全,而作出以下行為:
 - ▶接近/查察/越過/進入/接達禁地或出現於毗鄰之處 (包括透過電子、遙距方式或使用無人工具);或



- ▶取得/收集/記錄/製作/管有/傳達旨在對境外勢力 有用處的任何資料、文件或物品
- ▶ 如任何人勾結境外勢力,向公眾發佈虛假或具誤導性 的事實陳述,而該人:
 - ▶ 意圖或罔顧是否會危害國家安全;及
 - ▶知道陳述屬虚假或誤導;或
 - ▶有合理理由相信該項陳述屬虛假或具誤導性

第44條 - 在沒有合法權限下進入禁地等



〈〈〈 跨總區專題小組會議 **〉〉〉**

為提升警隊在不同總區的反爆竊應變能力,各區負責反鄉郊爆竊的人員於 六月二十日齊集將軍澳警署參與專題小組會議,攜手遏制全港各區的鄉郊爆竊 案。參與單位分別為山頂分區、港島總區野外巡邏隊、西貢分區、將軍澳警區、 沙田分區、田心分區、天水圍分區、元朗分區和新界北總區快速應變部隊。

人員就爆竊案疑犯及集團的犯案手法進行交流,並討論如何善用人力資源 有效應對鄉郊爆竊,歸納多個反鄉郊爆竊的有效措施,例如應用政府飛行服務隊 直升機及善用科技作出搜捕。人員亦分享推動市民參與反鄉郊爆竊的措施,以及 成功偵測爆竊案件的經驗。各單位亦於當日設立網絡平台,方便前線隊伍實時交 流情報及反爆竊策略。

〈〈〈 屯門警區 〉〉〉〉

為遏止村屋爆竊案及加強警方與地區組織的聯繫,屯門警區推出以「與社 群共同推動警政」為本的「屯結村絡計劃」,並於六月十三日由屯門警區指揮 官吳國章與屯門鄉事委員會主席劉業強主持啟動禮。39位村代表於當日獲委任 為「村絡守望大使」,將透過不同渠道向警方提供村內的罪案情報,協助警方 作針對性部署。保安公司於會場設置攤位,向各位「村絡守望大使」介紹最新 的保安產品及資料。

屯門警區往後將與「村絡守望大使」、村代表和地區服務及關愛隊伍加強 合作。人員除了在現場檢視村內保安漏洞 及提供防罪建議和保安工具外,亦會 按數據分析風險,靈活調派資源作 反爆竊巡邏。

元朗警區自二零二零年起推行「禦風」計劃,在預警、準備、應急和復原四 方面,持續加強村民應對極端天氣的能力。元朗警區今年六月上旬聯同消防處、 民政事務總署、渠務署、土木工程拓展署、民眾安全服務隊、香港紅十字會社區 備災服務、少年警訊、耆樂警訊及消防安全大使名譽會長會的代表及義工,到水 浸問題較嚴重的鄉村,向村民派發裝有急救毯、哨子、毛巾、手套及防災資訊單 張的防水福袋。本年度計劃獲元朗區少年警訊名譽會長會、耆樂警訊名譽會長會 及消防安全大使名譽會長會捐贈一批防汛沙袋予村民作緊急用途。

元朗警區亦於六月十九日聯同消防處、民政事務總署、天文台、渠務署、土 木工程拓展署、民眾安全服務隊及香港紅十字會社區備災服務在元朗大會堂舉辦 災難應變講座,講解風季前的準備、逃生應變知識及災後重建的安全措施,助村 民防患於未然。



大事故



新界南總區衝鋒隊和交通部於五月三十一日聯同消防處、醫院管理局、民 眾安全服務隊及香港危難應變學會於荃灣深井進行代號「緗堡」及「雨箭」的 跨部門重大事故演習,藉此測試及強化人員處理突發事故的應對、溝通和協作 能力。

演習模擬一宗多車連環相撞的交通意外,導致大量傷者需要即時撤離及救 援。新界南總區應變大隊指揮多個部門展開拯救行動及進行意外調查。人員亦 運用內部通訊軟件「P-chat」配合消防處的大量傷者事故檢傷分流系統提升傷 者識別效率。

是次演習共約200人參與,包括民政事務總署的地區服務及關愛隊伍和交 通安全隊成員,冀加強他們應對重大事故的認知。





月 務質素監察部於二零零三年起推行優質服務獎勵計劃,推廣警隊以民為本的優質服務文化。今屆吸引破紀錄近60個單位參賽,當中15支隊伍從初賽脱穎而出,並於六月二十日在警官會所進行決賽。

為確保評審過程的公正性,服務質素監察 部成立獨立評審小組,以嚴謹的評審準則評核 參賽作品。評審小組成員分別為助理處長(服務 質素)徐湘兒、獨立監察警方處理投訴委員會成 員陳正欣博士和施榮恆、警察學院名譽顧問張 仁良教授和巫俏冰博士、效率促進辦公室副效 率專員麥之駒及警隊總行政主任楊應敏。

得獎隊伍分別在「公共服務」、「專門服務」、「監管服務」、「危機管理」和「內部服務」五個組別中展現卓越的創新能力和服務質素,贏得評審小組的一致好評。頒獎典禮將於九月中舉行。完整得獎名單已於警察內聯網及警察告示欄公布。





PNC promotes crisis management at schools

To strengthen collaboration with schools to jointly prevent youth suicide, the Police Negotiation Cadre (PNC), together with the Psychological Services Group and the Hong Kong Jockey Club Centre for Suicide Research and Prevention, held a sharing session on campus crisis management for over 200 primary and secondary school principals, teachers, school social workers and psychologists on June 15.

The latest trend of student suicide was analysed while means to identify the warning signs and ways to handle such cases were shared to facilitate teachers identifying

vulnerable students so that timely intervention could be made and proper guidance offered. PNC officers also promoted the Practical Guideline for Crisis Management at Schools to the teachers, briefed them the role played by PNC and shared their experience with the teachers. It was hoped that the Force and schools would work hand-inhand to comprehensively promote the mental health of teenagers and implement suicide prevention for students.

All-out efforts against burglary

Inter-Region Focus Group Meeting

To enhance the Force's overall anti-burglary response across different Regions, subject officers responsible for anti-rural burglary work came together at Tseung Kwan O Police Station for a focus group meeting on June 20 to stem the rise in rural burglaries across the territory. The attending Formations comprised Peak Subdivision, Rural Patrol Unit of Hong Kong Island, Sai Kung Division, Tseung Kwan O District, Shatin Division, Tin Sum Division, Tin Shui Wai Division, Yuen Long Division and Quick Reaction Force of New Territories North.

The officers exchanged on the modus operandi of burglary suspects and syndicates, and discussed manpower-saving initiatives to ensure effective response to rural burglaries. They also pooled together good practices for preventing rural burglary, such as making use of the Government Flying Service helicopters and adopting technology for search and arrest. Public engagement measures against rural burglary and experience in detecting burglary cases successfully were also shared. An online platform was established on the day to facilitate different Formations sharing real-time intelligence and anti-burglary strategies.

TMDIST

To curb rural burglaries and foster connection between the Force and the community, Tuen Mun District (TMDIST) has launched the new community engagement and crime prevention initiative, Project Rurallink. District Commander of TMDIST Ng Kwok-cheung and Chairman of Tuen Mun Rural Committee Mr Lau Ip-keung officiated at the kick-off ceremony on June 13. 39 village representatives were appointed as Village Watch Ambassadors to provide crime information of the villages to the Force through various channels to assist the Force in making targeted deployments. Security companies set up booths at the event to introduce their latest products

and information to the Village Watch Ambassadors.

TMDIST will enhance collaboration with the Village Watch Ambassadors, village leaders and District Services and Community Care Teams. Apart from conducting hazard inspections in the villages to identify security inadequacies and offering crime prevention suggestions and solutions to plug security loopholes, TMDIST will also conduct data analysis to facilitate flexible deployment of resources for anti-burglary patrols.



YLDIST kick starts extreme weather precaution

Yuen Long District (YLDIST) has launched Project WINDBREAK since 2020 to enhance the villagers' capabilities against extreme weather in respect of early warning, emergency preparedness, response and recovery. In early June this year. YLDIST officers, together with representatives and volunteers from the Fire Services Department (FSD), Home Affairs Department (HAD), Drainage Services Department (DSD), Civil Engineering and Development Department (CEDD), Civil Aid Service (CAS), Community Resilience Service of Hong Kong Red Cross (HKRC), Junior Police Call (JPC), Senior Police Call (SPC) and Fire Safety Ambassador Honorary Presidents' Association (FSAHPA), visited villages in Yuen Long where flooding was comparatively severe. Waterproof fortune bags containing emergency blankets,

whistles, towels, gloves and informative leaflets were distributed. The Honorary Presidents Councils of YLDIST JPC, YLDIST SPC and FSAHPA showed their support for this year's project by donating flood prevention sandbags to the villagers.

YLDIST, in conjunction with the FSD, HAD, Hong Kong Observatory, DSD, CEDD, CAS and Community Resilience Service of HKRC, held a seminar on response to disasters at Yuen Long Town Hall on June 19. In the seminar, preparation for the typhoon season and knowledge about emergency response were explained, while safety measures for post-disaster reconstruction were shared to help villagers get well prepared before calamities take place.

NTS hosts major incident exercise

The Emergency Unit and Traffic of New Territories South (NTS), together with the Fire Services Department (FSD), Hospital Authority, Civil Aid Service and The Hong Kong Association for Conflict and Catastrophe Medicine, conducted an inter-departmental major incident exercise codenamed YELLOWFORTRESS cum RAINARROW in Sham Tseng, Tuen Wan on May 31 to test and strengthen the officers' response capability, communication and interoperability in handling major incidents.

The exercise simulated a traffic accident of multiple vehicles, resulting in mass casualties that required immediate evacuation and rescue. Under the command of the Regional Response Contingent of NTS, an inter-departmental rescue operation was mounted, with officers deployed for accident investigation. NTS officers also employed the internal communication application P-Chat to supplement the FSD's Patient Tagging System for Multiple Casualties Incidents to enhance identification of injured persons.

Service Quality Award Scheme

The Service Quality Wing (SQW) has launched the Service Quality Award Scheme (SQA) since 2003 to promote a culture of quality service and citizen-centric approach in the police service. The SQA 2023 attracted a record-breaking number of nearly 60 teams, among which 15 stood out and advanced to the final round held at the Police Officers' Club on June 20.

To ensure impartiality of the adjudication process, SQW formed an independent adjudication panel to judge the entries based on rigorous criteria. The panel comprised

TBHQ demonstrates eTraffic Ticket Platform to LegCo Panel on Transport

Enforcement (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2023 was passed in Legislative Council (LegCo) on June 19. The Force plans to provide one-stop services for gradually implement the electronic members of the public to facilitate fixed penalty notices (FPNs) in 2025 vehicle owners and drivers checking and roll out the eTraffic Ticket electronic FPNs and settling Platform (the platform) by phases. To facilitate LegCo members' in-depth understanding of its preparation work, the Force invited the Chairman Dr Chan Han-pan, members Mr Yick Chi-ming and Mr Lau Ip-keung of the LegCo Panel on Transport as well as LegCo member Ms Chan Kapui to visit the Traffic Branch Headquarters (TBHQ) on June 24 to learn about the new platform and procedure of serving electronic FPNs.

Assistant Commissioner (Support) (ACP SUP) Au Wing-leung led officers to brief the LegCo

The Electronic Traffic members on the preparation work for the digitalisation, as well as demonstrating the platform website and mobile app. The website would penalties by means of electronic payment at any time. The LegCo members actively shared opinions with the officers, hoping to enhance the overall efficiency of traffic enforcement through the application of technology for facilitating the Smart Mobility initiatives.

To accommodate the procedural changes brought by the digitalisation of FPNs, TBHQ will update the Force's mobile apps "e525" and "e570" in due course, and organise training workshops for frontline personnel.

New seat-belt design of patrol cars



The officer first fastens the seat belt from the AP's seat to the auxiliary buckle (circled in green). Once AP is seated, the officer can easily detach the seat belt from the auxiliary buckle and fasten the seat belt to the buckle at the AP's seat

To address the risk faced by officers the seat where AP sits to the fastening seat belts for arrested persons (APs) on police vehicles, Transport Division of the Traffic Branch Headquarters has collaborated with the Flectrical and Mechanical Services Department to re-design the seat belts.

> The new design features two newly installed auxiliary buckles on each side of the double-seat at the middle row. Also, the seat belts for APs in the middle of the back row are to be buckled outward. Before an AP is boarded onto the vehicle, the officer will extend and fasten the seat belt from

corresponding auxiliary buckle. Once the handcuffed AP is seated, the officer can easily detach the seat belt from the auxiliary buckle and fasten the seat belt to the buckle at the AP's seat without reaching across the AP.

The seat belts on 239 patrol cars will be changed from July onward, with priority given to Regional Emergency Units. The replacement exercise is expected to complete by mid-2025. The new design will become a standard procurement requirement for the Force's large vans in the future so that the safety and efficiency for escorting APs can be enhanced.

Fifth Advanced Incident Command Course

To further strengthen frontline commanders' capability in operational command and decision making, the Operations Wing (OPS Wing) ran the fifth Advanced Incident Command Course between June 11 and 14 for ten senior superintendents.

In addition to lectures and experience sharing by retired Commissioner Lee Ming-kwai, speakers from the Office for Safeguarding National Security of the Central People's Government in HKSAR and the Department of Justice, the course included a series of tabletop and

ground exercises on the themes of major public events, major incidents and terrorist incidents for enhancing the commanding and decision-making capability of participants.

Attendance of the course is a prerequisite for being selected to join the Command Cadre, which is a pool of commanders selected and trained to assume field command of major operations or incidents. To ensure that the commanding abilities and knowledge of commanders are up to date and always maintain at a highly effective level, the OPS Wing will continue to organise different thematic training and exercises tailor-made for different levels of commanders.



DCP MAN visits Uzbekistan

To actively build strategic partnership with law enforcement agencies along the Belt and Road countries, Deputy Commissioner (Management) Chan Joon-sun (DCP MAN) led a 14-member delegation to visit the Republic of Uzbekistan (Uzbekistan) from June 3 to 7. It was the first time for the Force to visit Uzbekistan for training and exchange.

The Head of Academy of Uzbekistan's Ministry of Internal Affairs (MIA) briefed the delegation on its police training facilities and had a meeting with DCP MAN. Both sides expressed their expectation to develop a long-term co-operative relationship and

promote training and exchange between police officers from the two places. The delegation also visited the Traffic Safety Department of Public Security Department of MIA, Command and Operational Centre and Public Relations Department of Internal Affairs of Tashkent City, Safe Tourism Department of Internal Affairs of Samarkand Region to study their organisational structures and working situations. The delegation and local officers shared the policing development and challenges faced in their respective jurisdiction.

During the visit, the Chinese Ambassador to Uzbekistan Mr Yu Jun met the delegation, affirming the successful outcome of this visit.



L.I.O.N. visits Beijing for exchange

The Director of Crime and Security Yip Wan-lung and Assistant Commissioner (Crime) Chung Wingman led officers of the Narcotics Bureau and five graduates from the Leadership Institute on Narcotics (L.I.O.N.) to visit the Narcotics Control Bureau, Ministry of Public Security (NCB MPS) in Beijing between June 20 and 22.

The L.I.O.N. graduates introduced the L.I.O.N. programme

and anti-drugs publicity efforts of Hong Kong to officials of NCB MPS and exchanged experience with antidrugs volunteers among local undergraduates to learn about each other's roles in anti-drugs public education. The delegation also visited the Lin Zexu drug prevention education base in Beijing to understand the significance and implications of Humen's opium destruction.

In 2020, he was awarded the TIDERIDER Medal. In 2021, he was awarded the Commissioner's Commendation for his leadership and professional ability displayed during and after Operation TIDERIDER.

The Special Duties Unit (SDU), the most elite formation of the Force, has been established for half a century since 1974. 60-year-old Station Sergeant Gima Lee, who has been in the Force for 42 years, passed the specialised units selection in 1988 and progressed to the SDU selection.

Gima revealed that during the selection, there had been scenes resembling plots in films. "The instructor would wake up trainees at night for accomplishing tasks, or arrange trainees to respond to a sudden raid in a dark room. Every moment was part of the assessment. Even when we sat down for a rest, the instructors would still continue to test our observation and memory." After 14 days of stringent selection, only eight of the two dozen shortlisted candidates advanced to the next stage of training. After several rounds of elimination, only Gima and another two candidates were chosen as SDU members. Gima was assigned to serve as a sniper responsible for ambush and cover.

Gima recalled his two most unforgettable missions during his 30 years in SDU. The first one was the fierce gun battle at the Kwangchow House in Tsuen Wan in 1992, in which his team successfully captured all the gangsters amidst gun-firing. In the other case, Gima's team was ordered to lurk outside a tin-sheet house in the Mai Po mangroves, preparing to smash an arms syndicate. "In that scorching summer, we spent two months there on recce, lurking and making arrest. The itchy and painful bites by the mosquitoes and fire ants were unbearable. Yet all team members held steadfastly to their positions until all the suspects were arrested and plenty of guns seized."

Gima was appointed as an instructor of SDU in 1998 and has witnessed the improvement of the assessment and training of SDU. "Taking swimming as an example, we used to focus on the route and distance only. Data analysis is now employed to ensure that the trainees reach various standards before passing the training. The 14-day advanced selection has also been condensed into the 7-day 'hell week'. SDU has also initiated a build-up course to help interested candidates get prepared."

In response to the ever-changing counter-terrorism situation, SDU officers are always on their mark. "Our responsibility, just like our original aspiration, is to safeguard Hong Kong in our best condition." He

encouraged colleagues with excellent physical fitness and perseverance to apply for SDU or other specialised units.

Since his retirement from SDU in 2019, Gima is still contributing to the Force on a post-retirement service contract. He has joined the Research and Development (R&D) Division of Police Tactical Unit (PTU) Headquarters to assist in the R&D and procurement of equipment. Gima has helped introduce stab-proof vests currently used on the frontline and the mixed reality training system. He hopes to help the Force introduce more quality equipment to empower the elites.
