

- 如遇到緊急事故,請立即致電(999) 報警求助。

資訊系統部於八月十日推出全新香港警察流動應用程式,集合超過50種 警隊電子服務,融合「公眾報料平台」、「電子報案中心」和「網上服務申 請平台」,優化市民使用警隊服務的流程體驗。

公眾報料平台

新增的公眾報料平台方便市民向 警方提供情報,以及舉報與國安和反 恐相關違法事件;而微信「影住駕」 舉報平台亦納入為舉報「駕駛者不當 行為」。

雷子報案中心

優化後的電子報案中心會納入香 港警察流動應用程式,並會同步提升 現有功能,包括地圖標示功能、自動 填表功能及表格儲存功能,讓市民就 「罪行」、「雜項」及「交通」共 16項非緊急個案作網上舉報。

網上服務申請平台

警隊近年重新整合電子申請平

台,市民只需使用一個帳號登入,便 能提交九類的服務或許可證申請,亦 可透過與電子申請平台連結的「網上 預約系統」享用九種服務。市民可使 用信用卡、轉數快及繳費靈等電子方 式付款,亦可線上跟進及查詢申請狀 態。至今已有超過28萬人次使用兩 個系統。

流動應用程式新增的地圖功能亦 為市民提供鄰近警署和交通黑點的資 訊。市民可透過程式的個人化訊息中 心,接收警隊公眾活動、特別交涌安 排以及防罪資訊等的推送信息。市民 亦可利用問答功能向人工智能聊天機 械人「YesSir」查詢警隊服務及詢問 騙案手法。

資訊系統部將於未來半年推出不



同的優化項目,包括擴展「案件管理 及調查系統」的部分功能、優化 「iLog 2.0」及推出更多「IT特寫」 及「IT知多啲」系列影片。資訊系統 部將按照《策略方針2025-2027》, 制訂資訊科技藍圖和數據策略,加強 系統兼容,邁向智慧警政。

少年警訊(少訊)周年大會2024暨少訊夏令營2025開展禮於八月二十日在八鄉少訊永久活動中心舉行。典禮邀得保安局局長暨少訊總名譽會長鄧炳強、處長暨少訊副總名譽會長周一鳴及助理處長(公共關係)暨少訊中央諮詢委員會主席陳思達擔任主禮嘉賓。

周年大會由助理處長(公共關係)主持, 逾170名嘉賓出席。大會向九位名譽會長、28 間學校支會代表、兩位學校支會老師以及13位 義務導師頒發感謝狀,感謝他們對少訊的支 持。此外,四位深資領袖亦獲頒傑出獎章。

保安局局長在開展禮致辭時表示,少 訊成立51年,一直積極策劃及推動多元化活動,增強青少年責任感、信心以及對社會的承擔,是撲滅罪行的教育基地,亦是培育明日領袖的搖籃。他感謝少訊中央諮詢委員會委會、各區少訊名譽會長、各界支持者和警隊人員的付出。

新界南衝鋒隊舉行演習 為十五運會作準備

是次演習模擬十五運會跨境公路自行車賽進行期間,分別發生恐怖分子策動襲擊;觀眾闖入賽道導致大量人士受傷;以及一名兒童失蹤人大受傷;以及一名兒童失蹤構構,10個政府部門及相關機構,逾300名人員及持份者有效調配人手、制服施襲者,以及進行緊急疏散和救援。

警隊將致力與相關政府部門及持 份者保持緊密聯繫,為即將舉行的 十五運會作周全準備。

東九龍總區行動部於八月十二日在東九龍總部舉行首個為第十五屆全國運動會(十五運會)和全國第十二屆殘疾人運動會暨第九屆特殊奧林匹克運動會(殘特奧會)而籌備的跨部門桌上演練,代號為「定海」,並由東九龍總區指揮官羅越榮博士主持開幕禮。14個政府部門及相關機構派出逾160名代表參與。

演練模擬將於啟德體育園舉辦的賽事,包括於八月舉行的群眾比賽保齡球項目決賽,以及於十一及十二月陸續舉行的七人制橄欖球、擊劍、男子手球和硬地滾球項目。演練模擬多個關鍵場景,包括場館安檢、人流管制、交通協調及突發事故應對等。

參與代表透過模擬情景深入討論,進一步明確職責分工及加強溝通協作,務求為運動員及觀眾帶來「簡約、安全、 精彩」的十五運會和殘特奧會。

有組織罪案及三合會調查科於七月二十三日在秀 茂坪警署舉行大型拘捕及臨時羈留處演練,以加強總 部應變大隊及總區應變大隊的刑偵小隊人員對處理大 型拘捕的能力。

演練模擬在第十五屆全國運動會期間,警隊於啟 德體育園的公共空間拘捕非法集結的示威者,並在短 時間內於秀茂坪警署設立臨時羈留處,有秩序地接收 被捕人士,以及應對各種突發情景。

演練期間,資訊系統部主要系統課亦示範使用其新開發的應用程式「iTHA」。程式精簡臨時羈留處的運作,提升前線人員處理被捕人士的效率及督導級人員對大型拘捕的指揮及控制能力。

刑事部代表團訪問德國聯邦刑事警察局

商業罪案調查科(商罪科)、網絡安全及科技罪案調查科及財富情報及調查科組成六人代表團,於七月二十八日至三十一日到訪德國威斯巴登的聯邦刑事警察局。

訪問期間,雙方就網絡罪案、經濟及金融罪案,以及反洗黑錢 行動等議題進行深入討論。德國聯邦刑事警察局代表亦進一步了解 香港警隊的專業調查課程。

率團的商罪科高級警司孔慶勳表示,訪問為香港警隊與德國聯邦刑事警察局提供寶貴平台,讓雙方在打擊網絡及金融罪行方面交流專業知識和實戰經驗,有助加強雙方

共同保護國際金融體 系的能力。

國際刑警組織加強協作保護兒童

國際兒童性剝削數據庫(數據庫)培訓於八月十八日至二十二日在警察總部的網絡靶場及警察學院的電腦室舉行,由兩名來自法國的國際刑警組織打擊兒童罪行單位人員主講。

數據庫由國際刑警組織管理,並在超過 70個國家或地區的執法單位中使用。透過高端的演算法分析資料、提供實時情報並有效 識別受害者和罪犯,以打擊兒童性剝削。 為期五天的培訓涵蓋多項主題,包括受害者識別、資料庫功能以及人工智能驅動的主動調查。網絡安全及科技罪案調查科和家庭衝突及性暴力政策組派出八名人員參與。首日另有超過15名虐兒案件調查組人員及警隊臨床心理學家參與交流性罪犯特徵。

是次培訓為人員提供了先進的全球情報 知識,並為警隊加入數據庫做好準備,透過 加強國際合作進一步鞏固保護兒童工作。





網絡安全及科技罪案調查科、數字政 **由** 策辦公室及香港互聯網註冊管理有限 公司合辦的網絡攻防精英培訓暨攻防大賽 2025於七月三十一日圓滿結束。為期三日 的活動吸引來自超過50間機構的130位網絡 安全從業員參與培訓,並有逾400支隊伍,

培訓方面,今年繼續採用「實戰為 主、理論為輔」的教學模式,更首次加入 與人工智能安全相關的內容,讓從業員在 模擬實境中識別漏洞、強化防禦及應對事 故等。攻防比賽則考驗參賽隊伍的

風險處理與即時應變能力。活動旨在提升 業界應對新型網絡威脅的能力,並促進 跨界協作與經驗分享,提高本地網絡 安全水平。



針對新蒲崗商貿區一帶的交通問題, 黃大仙警區與香港科技大學工學院研究團 隊合作進行黃大仙警區智慧交通管理計劃 (計劃),並於八月十九日在東九龍總區 警察總部舉行啟動禮。

計劃透過先進科技整合及分析交通數 據,從而制定最佳交通管理人手的調配方 案。計劃亦得到運輸署支持,協助優化新 蒲崗商貿區內個別交通燈號的配置。

計劃於今年六月在新蒲崗商貿區內進 行為期兩個月的測試,成功提升區內的行 車效率、縮減行人等候過馬路燈號的時間 及提升人力資源調配效能。黃大仙警區會 繼續優化計劃,並期望將計劃擴展至區內 其他交通繁忙的地方,以進一步改善區內 交通狀況。

Counter-terrorism Exercise BRAVELIGHT smoothly concludes

The Inter-departmental Counter Terrorism Unit conducted a counter-terrorism exercise codenamed BRAVELIGHT at the Kai Tak Cruise Terminal on August 28. This was the first large-scale exercise conducted under the newly established Three-tier Prevention Framework, as announced in the Chief Executive's 2024 Policy Address. The Emergency Monitoring and Support Centre was also activated during the exercise, which was overseen by the Chief Executive (CE) Mr John Lee, the Chief Secretary for Administration (CS) Mr Chan Kwok-ki, and the Secretary for Security (S for S) Mr Tang Ping-keung, thereby demonstrating the Government's commitment to counter-terrorism initiatives.

The exercise simulated a scenario in which terrorists attempted to launch an attack upon arriving in Hong Kong via a cruise ship, staging a knife attack and shooting in the terminal lobby. Their accomplices subsequently took a passenger ship hostage, leading to a gunfight with the Police onboard.

About 500 officers from various government departments and units participated in the exercise. For the first time, it was broadcast live on television and online. Nearly 200 volunteers from various community and youth organisations across different sectors and age groups were invited to participate in the exercise. Participants took on different roles in the exercise, gaining firsthand experience in applying the "Run, Hide, Report" emergency response advisory to protect themselves and others in critical situations.

The Commissioner Chow Yat-ming expresses his heartfelt appreciation to all police counter-terrorism units for their professionalism. He hopes that each unit can consolidate the experience gained from this exercise to further strengthen contingency planning, enhance collaboration with all stakeholders and strengthen public education on counter-terrorism, thereby improving the overall counter-terrorism capabilities of the Government and the community.

Anti-Money Laundering Month RECT. SERVICE STREET

The Financial Intelligence and Investigation Bureau (FIIB) organised the Anti-money Laundering (AML) Month in August, aimed at raising the general public and specific community's awareness of related risks through diversified activities and enhancing the public-private partnership to strengthen the efforts to combat money laundering. One of the highlights was the Financial Institutions AML Forum 2025 held on August 19. Over 200 representatives from policy bureaux, financial regulators, law enforcement agencies, academics, technology experts as well as over 40 representatives from financial institutions and institutions providing virtual asset services attended the event.

Commissioner Chow Yat-ming officiated the forum. During his speech, he pointed out that the rapid advancement of technology nowadays, the anonymity of virtual assets, the convenience of cross-border financial intermediation, and the widespread application of deepfake technology etc. have

significantly increased the complexity and severity of the money laundering issue. He emphasised that government departments, regulatory bodies and the private sector needed to work together to combat money laundering

activities. The Commissioner, along with the Deputy Chief Executive of Hong Kong Monetary Authority (HKMA) Mr Arthur Yuen and other officiating guests, also launched the icebreaker Project AccFencers in the opening ceremony, signifying that all sectors will sail forward together to break the ice with concerted efforts to smash the money laundering iceberg.

The forum comprised two panel

discussions, hosted by the officer in-charge of FIIB and the deputy in command of Cyber Security and Technology Crime
Bureau respectively. Professionals from banks, stored value facilities, academia, technology sector, those involved in AML and other stakeholders shared insights into measures to

Expert perspectives were also shared by Senior Public Prosecutor from the Department of Justice Ms Yuen Man-kong on prosecuting complicated money laundering cases, and Treasury Accountant Mr Lee Siusing on the role of Treasury Accountants in the investigation of loan-sharking cases.

Cyber Attack and Defence Elite Training cum Tournament

Training cum Tournament 2025, co-organised by the Cyber Security and Technology Crime Bureau, Digital Policy Office and Hong Kong Internet Registration Corporation Limited, successfully concluded on July 31. The three-day event attracted

130 cybersecurity practitioners from over 50 organisations for the training sessions, while the tournament drew the participation of around 1 400 individuals forming more than 400 teams.

The training this vear continued to adopt a practicaloriented approach supplemented by theoretical learning. Al security-related topics were introduced for the first time, enabling practitioners to identify vulnerability, enhance

the defence and respond to incidents in simulated scenarios. The tournament tested participating teams' ability to manage risks and make instant responses. The event aimed to enhance the industry's readiness against

emerging cyber threats and foster cross-sector collaboration and knowledge exchange, so as to enhance the local cybersecurity standard.



Wong Tai Sin Police Smart Traffic project

Wong Tai Sin District, in optimise the deployment of individual of the School of Engineering of the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (HKUST), conducted the Wong Tai Sin Police Smart Traffic project (the project) to address the traffic issue in the vicinity of San Po Kong business area. The Project was officially launched at a ceremony held on August 19 at the Kowloon East (KE) Police Regional Headquarters.

The project utilises advanced technology to integrate and analyse traffic data for formulating the best traffic management manpower deployment solution. It helped

Strengthening global efforts with INTERPOL for child protection

The International Child Sexual Exploitation (ICSE) Database training, led by two trainers from INTERPOL's Crimes Against Children (CAC) Unit in France, was held from August 18 to 22, at the Cyber Range and Computer Room of Police College

and utilised by law enforcement agencies in over 70 countries or regions, combats child sexual exploitation through advanced algorithms that

analyse data, deliver real-time intelligence, and efficiently identify victims and offenders.

The 5-day training covered vital topics such as victim identification, database functionalities, and Al-driven proactive investigations. Eight officers from Cyber Security and Technology Crime Bureau

and Family Conflict and Sexual Violence Policy Unit participated in the training while over 15 Child Abuse Investigation Unit officers and Police Clinical Psychologists made exchanges on sex offender characteristics during the first day of the training.

This comprehensive training provided officers The ICSE Database, managed by INTERPOL with advanced intelligence knowledge and prepared the Force to join the ICSE Database, reinforcing its commitment to child protection through enhanced international collaboration.

EU NTS conducts exercise for 15th NG

he Emergency Unit of New Territories South conducted an inter-departmental counter-terrorism and major incident exercise codenamed FLYINGEAGLE, YELLOWFORTRESS and RAINARROW at the Penny's Bay Community Isolation Facility on August 8. The exercise aimed to enhance the coordination and immediate response capabilities among relevant government departments and stakeholders in dealing with emergencies during the 15th National Games (NG). Director of Operations Lui Kamho also attended the exercise to show support and provide quidance.

The exercise simulated emergency scenarios during the cross-border road cycling race of the 15th NG, namely a terrorist attack against spectators; spectators trespassing onto the race course causing mass casualties; and a missing child case. Stakeholders and over 300 representatives from 10 government departments and relevant organisations effectively deployed manpower, subdued attackers, and coordinated emergency evacuation and rescue operations.

The Force is committed to maintaining close collaboration with relevant government departments and stakeholders and making comprehensive preparations for the upcoming 15th NG.

The Operations Wing of the Kowloon East mass participation event scheduled in August, and Region (KE) conducted the first inter-departmental tabletop exercise, codenamed PLACIDSEA, specifically organised for the 15th National Games (NG), the 12th National Games for Persons with Disabilities (NGD) and the 9th National Special Olympics Games (NSOG) at the KE Headquarters on August 12 with an opening ceremony officiated by the Regional Commander of KE Dr Law Yuetwing. 14 government departments and related organisations sent over 160 representatives for

The exercise simulated the events to be held at Kai Tak Sports Park, including the finals of bowling the rugby sevens, fencing, handball (men) and boccia events to be held one after another in November and December. The exercise simulated several critical scenarios including venue security screening, crowd control, traffic coordination and emergency response

Through the simulated scenarios, participating representatives conducted in-depth discussions, further defined job responsibilities and strengthened communication as well as collaboration, aiming to deliver a "simple, safe, and spectacular" 15th NG, 12th NGD and 9th NSOG for athletes and spectators.

OCTB holds large-scale exercise

The Organized Crime and Triad Bureau (OCTB) conducted a mass arrest and temporary holding area exercise on July 23 at Sau Mau Ping Police Station for crime group officers of Headquarters Response Contingent and Regional Response Contingents to enhance their capabilities in dealing with mass arrest.

The exercise simulated that the Force arrested demonstrators unlawfully assembling at the public open space in Kai Tak Sports Park during the 15th National Games, set up a temporary holding area to

process the arrested persons orderly at Sau Mau Ping Police Station within a short time. and responded to various unexpected

During the exercise, Major Systems Division of Information Systems Wing also demonstrated its newly developed application iTHA which streamlined the operation of Temporary Holding Area, and enhanced the efficiency of frontline officers in processing arrested persons as well as the command and control capabilities of supervisory officers in mass arrest.

ISW launches new HKP Mobile App

The Information Systems Wing (ISW) launched the new Hong Kong Police (HKP) Mobile Application (App) on August 10. The App has integrated over 50 police e-services, unified the Citizen Eye, the e-Report Centre (e-RC), and the Online Application Platform, thereby significantly enhancing users' experience when accessing police services.

Al Chatbot "YesSir

Citizen Eye

The newly integrated Citizen Eye tip-off platform enables users to provide intelligence information and report illegal activities related to national security and counterterrorism while "Project PROVE" under the WeChat platform is now incorporated into the form of "Motorist Misbehaviour".

e-RC

The optimised e-RC is integrated into the HKP Mobile App. With its existing features enhanced, which include map indication function. automated form filling function and form saving function, e-RC allows users to report 16 types of nonemergency incidents covering crime, miscellaneous, and traffic.

Online Application Platform

The Force has recently restructured the electronic application platform. Users can now log in with a single account to submit applications for nine categories of services or permits. The system also links with the online booking system for nine types of services. Payment can be made electronically via credit card, Faster Payment System, and PPS, Users can also track and inquire about application status online. To date, over 280 000 users have utilised the two systems.

The HKP Mobile App has introduced a new mapping feature that provides users with information on nearby police stations and traffic black spots. Through the App's personalised Message Centre, users can receive instant notifications about police public events, special traffic arrangements, and crime prevention information.

Additionally, users can use the Q&A feature to inquire about police services and fraud tactics from the built-in Al Chatbot "YesSir".

Looking ahead, ISW will launch further upgrades over the next six months, such as expanding certain functions of the Case Management and Investigation System, optimising iLog 2.0, and releasing more "IT Capture" and "Let's talk IT" video series. ISW will continue to advance its IT blueprint and data strategy according to the "Strategic Directions 2025-2027", and strengthen system compatibility to move towards smart policing.

FEG's First Woman Motorcycle Sergeant

Delivering Empathy and Warmth at Professional Speed

Woman Sergeant Lam Lai-kuen, attached to the Enforcement and Control Division, Traffic New Territories South, has set a professional example with exemplary performance since she became the first female member of the

Force Escort Group (FEG) in

2013. This elite team is responsible for escorting dignitaries and national important artefacts, and the standards of driving skills and teamwork are very high. They will even play a crucial role in the 15th National Games (NG) in November.

As a petite woman police officer, Lam Lai-kuen tells frankly that handling a 290-kilogram police heavy motorcycle is extremely

challenging, "I was unfamiliar with motorcycle operations when I entered the profession. With a weight of only 61 kilograms, I had to rigorously train my physical fitness and vehicle control skills so as to achieve good results by a little effort." Whether wearing thick and heavy gear on duty or enduring the sun and rain, she remains perseverant and even took additional training during her spare time to achieve synergy with her vehicle.

Her perseverance helped her stand out in the rigorous selection process, and became one of the few female members of the escort group. Lam Lai-kuen emphasises that each mission is a perfect embodiment of teamwork, "Although we are responsible for the peripheral escort, being able to closely coordinate with professional teams such as the VIP Protection Unit to complete the mission collaboratively, safely and efficiently is the greatest satisfaction."

Her professionalism is also embodied in her daily work. Late last year, while patrolling the Tsing Sha Highway, she not only swiftly handled a traffic incident and also proactively acted as an interpreter to assist the victim to communicate with involved parties. resolving the issue satisfactorily in just 20 minutes. The victim later expressed gratitude through social platform

praising her "efficient yet warm" approach, making this heartwarming story become a popular online anecdote.

Lam Lai-kuen humbly states, "This is just what every police officer would do as part of the duty. As a traffic police officer, handling road incidents is inherently our professional duty."

What deserves attention is the commendation ribbon on Lam Lai-kuen's uniform, known as the Commissioner's Commendation or, literally, "Flower Chicken Rope", which marks her bravery during the 2019 Yau Ma Tei supermarket shooting incident. As a sergeant in the Emergency Unit of Kowloon West at the time, she spotted a knife-wielding man heading to the supermarket for revenge during patrol and immediately alighted to pursue him with her colleagues. "When we rushed into the supermarket, the man had already struck the manager's head with the knife. After our warnings with pistols drawn failed, my colleague decisively shot and subdued the assailant," Lam Lai-kuen recalls. Fortunately, the assaulted manager finally recovered and personally thanked the police.

Looking forward to the upcoming 15th NG, Lam Lai-kuen is eager to witness historical moments in her

escort role. She firmly believes that the Force not only demonstrates the efficient "Hong Kong speed" but also embodies empathy and warmth when "serving Hong Kong", "Every police officer's effort is a miniature of the Force's professionalism. With concerted efforts, we can surely complete the mission successfully!"
